In 2020, the City of East Moline envisioned the Greater Downtown Master Plan with the help of local leaders, businesses, and residents. Now,

with an infusion of federal RAISE grant funds (\$23.7 million!), East Moline is moving forward with making the Master Plan a reality. With a dedicated design team, we're developing enhanced connections between Main Street/15th Avenue, The Rust Belt, and The Bend through pedestrian-friendly amenities, improved railroad crossings, new landscaping, more outdoor event space, and artistic touches. East Moline has a bright future ahead!
